Hahndorf Soccer Club believes in Respect

Respect your coach
Respect your team mates
Respect your Club

There are three things to remember

1) Listen

- when your coach is speaking your mouth is closed
- ask questions, however wait for your coach to finish and do not "talk back" or argue
- follow the directions of your coach during training sessions and matches

2) Pay Attention

- this means even if you are listening, you are not being a distraction to others by playing with a ball, jostling a team mate or mucking around.

3) Remember

- always show respect to the game officials, opponents and the equipment/facilities of both Hahndorf and the opposing club.
- abusive language/violent behaviour/harassment of any player/official/spectator is unacceptable.

Then everyone can enjoy being out playing soccer and most importantly having fun.

To encourage respectful behaviour your team will be issued with vouchers throughout the season from our sponsors to receive a treat. Your coach/team manager will distribute these to those players who are displaying respect.

If you choose NOT to be respectful then there will need to be a consequence as follows.

- 1) Warning- you will be clearly told that you are being warned and why.
- 2) Yellow Card- first half of the next game on the bench
- 3) Red Card- the next game you will sit on the bench. The player is required to attend the game otherwise the penalty is rolled over to the next game.

In the event of a yellow or red card either your coach or Tracy Weyland (Junior Coordinator) will speak to your parents to explain what happened and answer any questions there may be.
